Julie Titone will read from the book, Boocoo Dinky Dow: My Short, Crazy Vietnam War, a Northwest veteran's unusual illustrated memoir co-authored with the late artist Grady Myers. The book takes its title from soldiers' slang pronunciation of "beaucoup dien cai dau," meaning very crazy. Washington State Magazine praised the book and described it as "Part 'M*A*S*H' and part 'Full Metal Jacket.'"

In 1969, Myers was a big, artistic Idaho teenager when the U.S. Army overlooked his nearsightedness and transformed him into an M-60 machine gunner. He recounts his military initiation at Fort Lewis and describes the intensity of Vietnam. Myers returned from four months in Vietnam with serious injuries and a Purple Heart. He studied art in Seattle and went on to a professional art career. His war-related work is part of the National Veterans Art Museum collection. He died in 2011.
